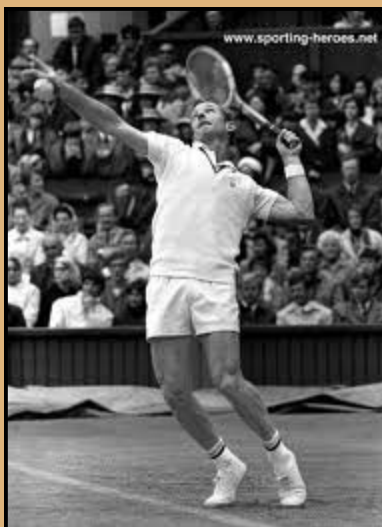

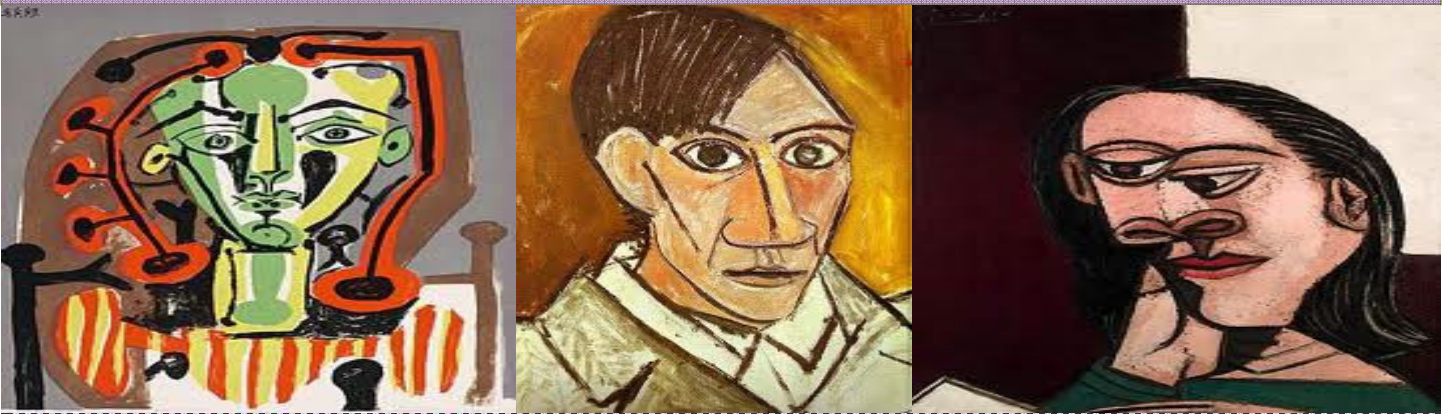
Cathy Zito's "Treasury Note"

July 2010 Board Meeting Minutes

In attendance: Larry Falgoust, Kerri Becker, Kay Boutte, Cheri Charvet, Cathy Zito, Diane Ledet, Carolyn Hefner

June minutes accepted.

Swim/Dive – JCCA Dive MOC is Fri., 7/23. 10 divers are representing Bissonet. JCCA Swim MOC is Sat and Sun. at Woodlake CC. 45 swimmers are representing Bissonet.

Bissonet will provide a “Breakfast of Champions” on Fri. The award ceremony is 8/15

Motion to purchase gift cards for swim/dive volunteers accepted.

Bissonet Facebook page – April Indovina presented the Bissonet Facebook page she created to the Board for review. The motion was approved to have April continue as Administrator until May 4, 2011, with the Board’s option to review her work and replace her at any time. It was brought to the Board’s attention that another Bissonet Facebook page exists for dissemination of tennis information. The Board decided that this page should be renamed if it is going to continue posting information, as Bissonet Country Club now has an official page approved by the Board.

Lightning/Thunder Policy - Bissonet Country Club follows policy set by American Red Cross and NOAA. We don’t deviate from their guidelines.

August Hours – Pool managers got start dates for area schools to come up with the August pool schedule. Due to lack of employees, as well as potential membership use of the club. The Board asked the managers to check to see what time staff schools end, and what is the earliest possible time they can make it to work. The Board is working with the managers to due the best we can to service the members with pool open times. Tentative times were approved by the Board: beginning 8/11 – M – Th: 5-9PM, Fri: 5-10, Sat & Sun.: regular hours. Last open date Labor Day: 10 AM – 9PM.

Thursday Pool Closing time – It was asked if the pool can stay open until 10PM so that children of tennis players can swim. This will be addressed next year. The concern is that the children move to the grassy area when the pool closes and are unsupervised.

Adult Swim – possibly 9/3, pending employee procurement. 9/17 from 7 – 11PM.

Financial Statement: Revenue down \$13,000 from last year. Cost of goods for Concessions is up, Swim team revenue is down \$1,000. Bar is down \$1,400, Jr tennis is down \$2,000. Membership is down. It was suggested that we watch our expenses.

Our financial situation has been further compromised by members who are not paying dues on time. We have insurance to pay, payroll to meet, loans, and pool and tennis maintenance. There are 10 members who owe Bissonet \$1,000.00 or more in delinquent dues. They, as well as those 2 or more quarters behind, have ignored numerous reminders via phone, email, and mail. It has created a situation in which the club’s solvency at risk. The Board is taking legal action against the 10 members, and will try to contact others again before seeking alternative action.

Membership – Diane said that we are at 407 with 3 more resignation requests today. The Bylaws state that new members must have a member in good standing sponsor them, and sign their name to the prospective member’s application.

Guest Fees - Motion accepted to fine members who do not pay guest fees \$25.00.

Safety/Insurance at Bissonet – Cheri suggested that we have a safety expert come out and assess our grounds. The cost will be approx. \$400.00. His recommendations could help us avoid future claims. Discussion tabled until next meeting. A second injury occurred when a truck exiting Bissonet property rolled over a pipe that popped up and struck the employee. Cheri suggested having an attorney draw up a “hold harmless” for contractors to sign when they enter the property

Serious Delinquent Accounts – Members with balances of \$1,000 or greater will receive certified letters advising them that their membership to Bissonet has been revoked. These members have ignored phone calls, emails, and notices.

Advertisement in Bulletin: Motion accepted to use the same fees as were used for the hard copy, with fees adjusted accordingly at Diane’s discretion.

July 2010 Board Meeting Minutes, cont.

Entertainment – Luau: 8/14. Larry will try to put something together for \$20. Adult swim in conjunction with 9/3 bar night from 10 – 12PM, possible adult swim night on 9/17 will be discussed at August meeting.

Meeting adjourned @ 9:40 PM.

Bissonet Maned-Downs Country Club Operating Rules

Effective April 18, 1977
Revised August 18, 2010

SO THAT ALL MEMBERS MAY ENJOY THE FACILITIES OF BISSONET MANED DOWNS COUNTRY CLUB, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS HAS ESTABLISHED THE FOLLOWING RULES:

ARTICLE I

Definitions:

Club Facilities – “Club Facilities” include the clubhouse, bathhouses, pools, tennis courts and all ground areas.

Guest – Any person not a member of the Club.

Member – As defined in the Articles of Incorporation and By-Laws.

Club Manager – Any person designated by the Board of Directors with authority over the Club’s employees and facilities.

ARTICLE II

Eligibility – Only those members in good standing (whose dues and assessments are not in arrears) shall be eligible to use the club facilities, except:

Guests accompanied by a member may use the facilities as set forth below,

Non-members may be invited to attend functions as the Board may see fit.

Official visitors may be invited to attend particular functions as the Board of Directors may see fit,

Persons who rent the club may use the club facilities as set forth in the renting procedures and rental agreement.

ARTICLE III

Identification – Members using the facilities must appear on the official membership roster maintained by the club. Guests may use facilities as specified below. Members who allow non-members to use their identification or who falsify the status of non-members will be subject to fine or expulsion.

ARTICLE IV

General Behavior – All members and their guests must conduct themselves in a proper manner when using club facilities. Rowdiness and use of profane and vulgar language are prohibited. Parents must restrain children from damaging club property. Parents of

children who damage any of the club facilities shall be responsible for payment of such damage. They shall also be responsible for damages caused by their guests.

ARTICLE V

Fines and Suspension – Any member or members may be fined, or suspended, or expelled, in accordance with the Articles of Incorporation and the By-Laws for violation of the club rules as herein set forth. When members are suspended, use of the club facilities shall be denied all members of their family. However, suspension of a child shall not necessarily mean suspension of the other members of his or her family. Continued violations may lead to expulsion from the club.

ARTICLE VI

Club Employees – The Club Manager, or others designated by the Board, shall have sole charge of all Club employees. No other persons are authorized to instruct them in performance of their duties.

ARTICLE VII

Pets – No pets of any kind are allowed in any part of the club facilities, without the permission of the Board or Club Management.

ARTICLE VIII

Guests –

A member or dependent member 10 years old or older must accompany Guest(s) with written permission of the parent, who will be responsible for the guest(s). Guests must be registered with the gatekeeper upon entry.

The fee for a guest using the pool and/or tennis courts will be \$5.00 per day, and is to be paid as the guest is registered with the gatekeeper. When no gatekeeper is on duty, tennis guest(s) are to be registered in the guest book located at the tennis courts and the fee paid with the next dues statement. Failure to register a tennis guest prior to play will result in a \$10.00 fine.

House guest from outside the New Orleans-Jefferson metropolitan area, visiting in the home of a member, may upon the request of the member, be admitted to use the club facilities on a weekly basis at a fee of \$40.00 per week per family, for not more than two consecutive weeks. Additional use may be authorized by the Board upon request by a member. Each request will be handled on a case-by-case basis.

A guest may not use the facilities more than 12 times per calendar year.

ARTICLE IX

Pool Rules –

Hours: General swimming from 10:00 AM to 9:00PM, daily, Monday through Thursday, and from 10:00 AM to 10:00 PM on Friday, Saturday, and Holidays. Sunday pool hours are from 12:00 PM to 10:00 PM. These hours apply daily during the season, except:

The pools may be closed for cleaning, for health reasons, and when, in the discretion of the lifeguards or manager, the weather makes swimming hazardous.

The pool may be closed up to one hour earlier than the stated times when in the opinion of the manager on duty weather or conditions indicate that the use of the pool is expected to be less than five swimmers.

The pool may be closed to general swimming upon majority vote of the Board for use in special and private functions, swimming meets, diving meets, swimming lessons, etc.

A lifeguard must be on duty on the stand at the pool at all times when the pool is in used for general swimming. When the pool is used for special or private functions, the party using the pool will be required to furnish a lifeguard and pay their fee as determined by the Board.

Members in good standing desiring to use the club and pool for special or private functions may apply to the Board, and the majority of the Board may approve the time and use requested upon payment of a rental fee to be set by the Board.

Persons using the pool at unauthorized times will be subject to fine and/or suspension.

An adult or responsible person must accompany children under the age of 13 after 6:00 PM for use of any club facilities. An adult or a responsible person, 13 years or older, must responsibly accompany children under the age of 10 when using the club's facilities prior to 6:00 PM.

Children wearing flotation devices in the pool must be accompanied at all times by a parent or adult in the pool or on the pool apron unless the child has successfully passed the swim test.

Children who wear diapers are not permitted in the large or baby pool unless their diaper is covered with snug-fitting outer plastic pants or an appropriate equivalent.

Attire: All persons using the swimming pool must wear an appropriate swimming suit.

Entrance to Pools: All persons using the pools or the area surrounding the pools must enter at the main gate.

Authority: The lifeguard in charge of the pool shall have complete jurisdiction over the pools, and he (she) shall have the authority to restrict any person from the use of the pools. If management feels that is in the best interest of the Club to restrict its use to a member or a child of a member for more than one day, the

President of the Board and at least one other Board member must approve this. If a member younger than 12 is restricted from using the pool for the remainder of the day, the Club Manager shall call the parents before sending them home. The lifeguard in charge shall report any misconduct to the Club Manager, or his (her) representative.

Guests: A member who will be responsible for the guest(s) must accompany Guest(s). The member will identify the guest(s) and enter name, address and age in the guest register. The member is required to pay the guest fee at the time of entry.

Miscellaneous Rules:

The following activities, and any other deemed dangerous by the lifeguard are prohibited for the safety of all:

- Use of bottles and/or glass containers in or around the pool and in play areas.
- Running, shoving and throwing others in the pool.
- Attempting feats beyond skill or endurance.
- Swimming when unauthorized, such as closures for cleaning, thunderstorms, rest break, etc.
- Throwing trash or food in or around the pool.
- Throwing or snapping towels in or around the pool.
- Eating, drinking or smoking in the pool or on the concrete apron around the pool.
- Tampering with any pool equipment in or around the pools.
- Use of excessively large swimming aids, rafts, etc. in the pool.
- Wearing breakable eyeglasses or sunglasses in the pool.
- All parties where a member plans to have 10 or more people attending must be coordinated and approved by a manager at least two weeks prior to the scheduled activity.
- No unscheduled team parties or events are permitted.
- All parties are restricted to the West side of the picnic area (Page Drive). Shelters will be assigned to each party.

At ten minutes to the hour, for a ten-minute period, during each hour of general swimming, all swimmers below the age of 18 will leave the pool for a period of rest.

Any non-member receiving swim lessons must pay \$5.00 over the cost of the lesson per session. The swim instructor is responsible for paying this fee to the Club.

ARTICLE X

Tennis –

General:

- a) Tennis courts are available for play from sunrise to 11:00 PM.
- b) The last person to play each night must turn off the lights on the tennis courts and lock the gate.
- c) A court reservation logbook, an open court waiting list and a guest book are located at the courts. All members should sign the book prior to play each day. No tennis play is allowed without sign-in.
- d) Anyone wishing to charge to give tennis lessons on club courts must obtain approval from the Board. All previously approved tennis instructors must be reviewed and approved again by the Board prior to May of each year. Any non-member receiving tennis lessons must pay \$5.00 over the cost of the lessons per session. The tennis instructor is responsible for remitting this fee to the Club.
- e) Proper tennis attire must be worn on the tennis courts. This shall include tennis shoes, and top for both men and women. A swimsuit is not acceptable.
- f) The Club Manager may close the tennis courts when in his (her) opinion weather conditions make play hazardous.

Rules: Latest tennis court rules will be published in the Bulletin at least once each year.

The Club assumes no responsibility for tennis players who are not signed in on the reservation book.

ARTICLE XI

Grounds –

Hours: Hours during which the club grounds will be open will be posted and/or published in the Bulletin. At other times, the grounds will be closed and their use will be prohibited.

Miscellaneous Rules:

Members are requested to follow any rules promulgated for the use of sports equipment, barbecue facilities, etc.

Sports equipment is not to be removed from the club premises without specific approval of the Manager or his (her) representative.

Outdoor furniture must be used properly.

Trash, paper, etc., must be deposited in trash containers. Special attention should be paid to proper disposal of dangerous items, such as soft drink cans and tabs. No glass containers are allowed on the grounds.

Climbing fences, buildings or trees on club property is prohibited.

No furniture or accessories will be removed for the Club's premises.

ARTICLE XII

Bar and Lounge –

Hours: Hours during which the bar will be tended will be posted and/or published in the Bulletin. The members may use the lounge during club hours, except as otherwise posted or noted in the Bulletin. Please keep all seating areas and surfaces neat and clean.

Attire:

Wet swimming suits are specifically prohibited in the lounge. Members may not enter until dry enough to avoid wetting the floor and furniture.

Shoes and shirts are required for entry to the bar and lounge.

Miscellaneous: No one under eighteen years of age is allowed in the bar and lounge.

There will be no cigar smoking in the clubhouse, including the bar.

ARTICLE XIII

Teen Room –

1) Hours: The Teen Room is open to members during the club open hours, except as otherwise posted and/or published in the Bulletin.

Attire: Members in swimwear may not enter until dry enough to avoid wetting the floor. Persons may not wear swimsuits while in the game room. Absolutely no wet swimwear or towels are allowed on the furniture. A short must be worn when in the Teen Room.

Safety: Individuals who are in wet clothing or swimwear, or not wearing shoes may not play or be near electric or electronic games.

Conduct: No rowdiness, improper language, or abuse of the equipment and games is allowed. No smoking or consumption of alcoholic beverages is permitted when the room is in use as the Teen Room or for Teen Club functions.

A responsible person must accompany children under 10 years old from Club opening until 6:00 pm, and children under 12 years old from 6:00 pm to closing while in the Teen Room.
