Financial Corner **August 2011**

College Savings Program

As summertime close to and end, many of us across the country redirect our attention to preparing for the upcoming school year. With the rising cost of tuition, there are compelling reasons for parents and grandparents to consider saving early for a child's college education. College costs have been racing ahead at rates above 6% annually – far ahead of official inflation figures. Yet, the most recent study shows that while an overwhelming number of parents expect their children to pursue higher education, nearly 40% are not saving for it. Moreover, of those who are, only 32% are using a tax-advantaged savings plan, according to the student loan company Sallie Mae.

One tax efficient method of saving for college education is to invest in a college 529 savings plan. College 529 savings plans are tax-advantaged savings vehicles that let you save money for the college expenses of a named beneficiary, such as a child or grandchild. A college savings plan allows you to invest after tax dollars on behalf of a named beneficiary and the funds may be withdrawn tax free if used to pay qualified college expenses. For example, the IRS considers college tuition, books, and room and board to be qualified educational expenses.

In addition, 529 plans include generous contribution ceilings. They vary from state to state, but most are \$300,000 or higher. There may be a state tax break involved, too, if you invest in your home state's 529 plan. Similar plans offered by other states are not likely to provide the same tax benefits. Contributions, which grow tax-free, remain the property of the account owner and may have little impact on scholarship and financial aid possibilities. Donors may combine up to five years' worth of gift tax exclusions (which, for 2011, is \$13,000) for a one-time contribution of \$65,000.
